Dear friends,

With the gradual lifting of restrictions, we can begin the process of re-opening up the Cathedral. As of yesterday, 16th May, the Cathedral is open in a limited manner from 9am-12noon for private prayer each week day. A limit of ten people are able to gather in the Cathedral at any one time. Inside the Cathedral, you will be asked to maintain physical distancing (1.5m).

We are also required to keep a record of your contact details and time of your visit in the event the Department of Health needs to contact you over concerns that you may have come in contact with someone who tests positive for Covid19. To ensure that the Cathedral complies with these requirements, I am sure that you will be co-operative with these measures and maintain physical distancing.

Confession will recommence from 10-11am each week day, including Saturday. To comply with distancing requirements, Reconciliation will be held in the Hanly Room in the Francis Rush Centre.

These measures will be in place until mid-July when, all going well, maximum numbers will be lifted to 100. We will have more information about our strategies for this closer to the time. In the meantime, live-streaming of Masses and other liturgical celebrations will continue as currently scheduled.

Please be aware that a limit of 10 people will require significant management as well as your willing co-operation. When you do visit the Cathedral or the Chapel for quiet prayer in the coming weeks, please be conscious of the amount of time that you spend in the worship spaces as extended visits will limit the opportunities for others. We will also insist on the physical distancing measures that we have become so familiar with in recent months. With your co-operation, we can ensure that the re-opening of the Cathedral will run smoothly while maintaining our health and social responsibilities towards one another. Let us be grateful but not complacent as we enter this new phase. *Fr. Anthony*


