

ENTRANCE SONG

Psalm 84

At the conclusion of the Introit, a bell is sounded. The assembly **responds** as the Choir and Ministers process towards the altar with the following translation of the Introit text. The <u>first</u> verse (which is the Antiphon) is repeated after the final verse.


