Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost, some fifty days after Easter, when the gift of the Holy Spirit which descended upon the Apostles in that upper room, and ignited them to go forth into the world and be the messengers of the Good News. Pentecost, from the Greek for 'fiftieth', remains our biggest Sunday celebration after the Day of Resurrection (Easter Sunday).

On certain Feasts (such as today, again in two weekends' time on Corpus Christi, also on Easter Day, and the Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows – though the early church contained many more than the four we celebrate today), our liturgy calls for the image-laden *sequence*, an additional hymn of praise inserted into the Liturgy of the Word before the proclamation of the Gospel. Today's sequence dates back to the twelfth century, with its ancient Latin title of 'Veni, Sancte Spiritus', or 'Come, Holy Spirit'.

You might want to take today's newsletter with you after Mass and pray this beautiful prayer at home throughout the week.

Linked with this is this weekend's first hymn, 'Spirit sent in Jesus' name'. Richard Connolly, perhaps Australia's most prolific and renowned hymn composer, died last month in Sydney aged 94. His rich legacy of hymns (many with the prose of noted author James McAuley) and Mass settings sit at the core of our distinct Australian church music literature, continuing to inspire generations of worshippers. Many of these hymns remain in use for us week by week as we come to celebrate Mass at the Cathedral and St Patrick's.


