THE SEQUENCE OF CORPUS CHRISTI [St Thomas Aquinas, 13th Century]

Ecce Panis Angelorum, Factus cibus viatorum Vere panis filiorum, Non mittendus canibus. In figuris praesignatur, Cum Isaac immolatur, Agnus Paschae deputatur, Datur manna patribus.

Bone pastor, panis vere, Jesu, nostri miserere: Tu nos pasce, nos tuere, Tu nos bona fac videre In terra viventium. Tu qui cuncta scis et vales, Qui nos pascis hic mortales: Tuos ibi commensales, Coheredes et sodales Fac sanctorum civium.

Come, behold, the bread of angels, this our strength on pilgrims' way. For the children God is giving manna for our bread each day. Now the sign of Isaac telling: Christ has conquered on each day.

Hear our prayers, O kindly Shepherd, be for us true living bread. Grant us peace in all our doings, to our resting place be led, forth with all the saints now dwelling we the body, you the Head. Come, behold the Bread of Angels! What a marvellous image presented to us by St Thomas Aquinas, one of the Church's greatest theologians and teachers. We are nourished spiritually and physically at the Altar of the Lord where we too join the endless Heavenly Banquet. This is the true reason that receiving Our Lord in the Eucharist remains the summit of our faith. Food for the journey, we return to be fed and, by doing so, capture but a mere glimmer of heaven and the life to come.

The Sequence is used on four special days in the Church's calendar where we sing an additional hymn of praise, accompanying the proclamation of the Gospel. Historically, Sequences originated in the fourth century, and there were many more than what we celebrate in the modern Roman Rite (Easter Sunday, Pentecost, Corpus Christi and Our Lady of Sorrows). Their mystical, deeply poetic prose draws us into an even more deeper understanding of the faith.

Today's Solemnity of Corpus Christi is no mere recollection or memorial of the Last Supper. It is our personal invitation to the Feast of Heaven. Christ is OUR heavenly food. We especially welcome today First Communicants joining the Endless Banquet for the very first time.

See what wonders can take place when we let Our Lord in! Come, and behold.


