With the Easter festivities still ringing in our ears, we now turn to the major events for the 150th anniversary of the opening and blessing of the Cathedral. Last Tuesday, 2nd April, marked the 102nd anniversary of opening and blessing of the transepts by Archbishop Duhig, the last major renovations prior to the work completed in 1989. It reminds us that Cathedrals are always a work in progress and St. Stephen's is no different.

On **May 10th and 11th**, we will be blessed to have the **Queensland Symphony Orchestra** perform in the Cathedral—the first time in almost 50 years. If you haven't purchased a ticket yet, please see the details inside the newsletter. It will be an event not to be missed. **Please note** that the performance will mean some changes to our Saturday evening Mass, which will be held in the chapel on May 11. The following weekend will be our major celebrations.

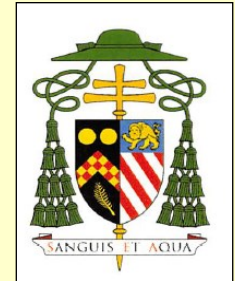
On **Friday May 17, at 12:30pm**, we will be acknowledging the actual date of the anniversary with the

Papal Nuncio and bishops from around Australia. That Friday evening (**6pm**) will be an ecumenical celebration, with a marvellous combined ecumenical choir. This will be a joyous opportunity to gather with our ecumenical sisters and brothers in the inner-city and strengthen our witness to the city of Brisbane.

Saturday, **May 18**, will be **Archbishop Mark's Golden Jubilee of Priesthood** which will also be a very special occasion. That Saturday evening we will celebrate an extended Pentecost Vigil (**6pm**) praying for the mission of the Archdiocese. On **Sunday May 18, Pentecost Sunday**, we will combine both the **10am and 12noon**, and commence at **10:30am** so that our Cathedral community might celebrate together as one family and enjoy a festival in the precinct afterwards. This will be a grand and fitting finale to this year of celebration.

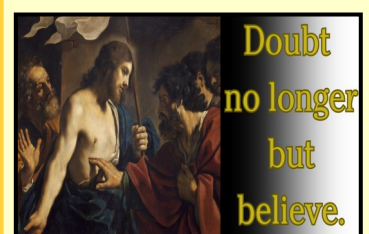

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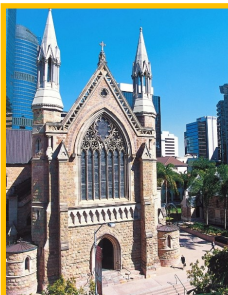
**Sunday 14 April 2024**

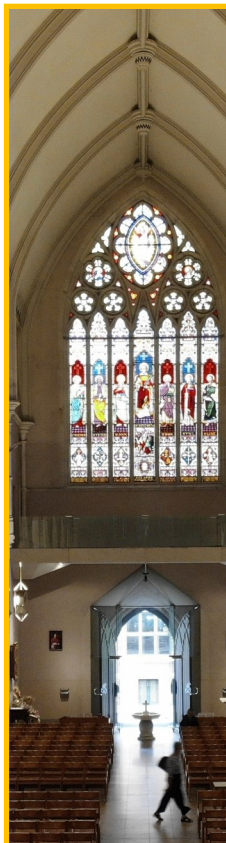

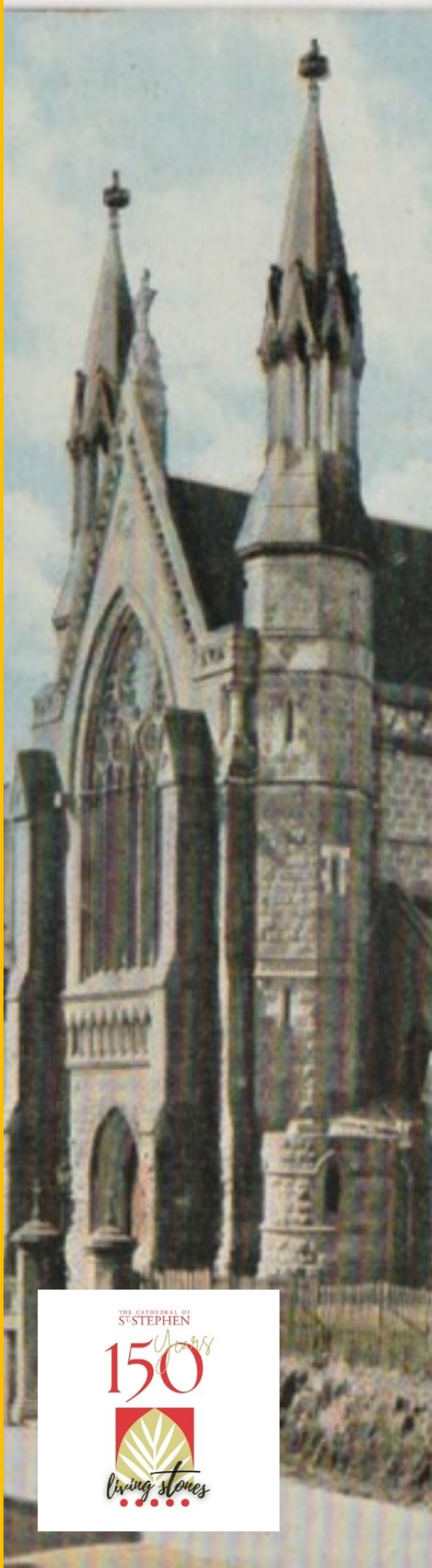
