equip us for such suff'rings as glorify your Name.

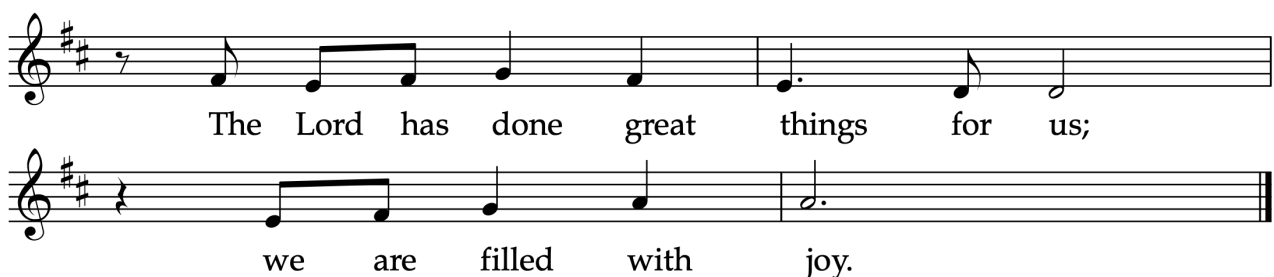
Then let us praise the Father and worship God the Son

equip us for such suff'rings as glorify your Name.

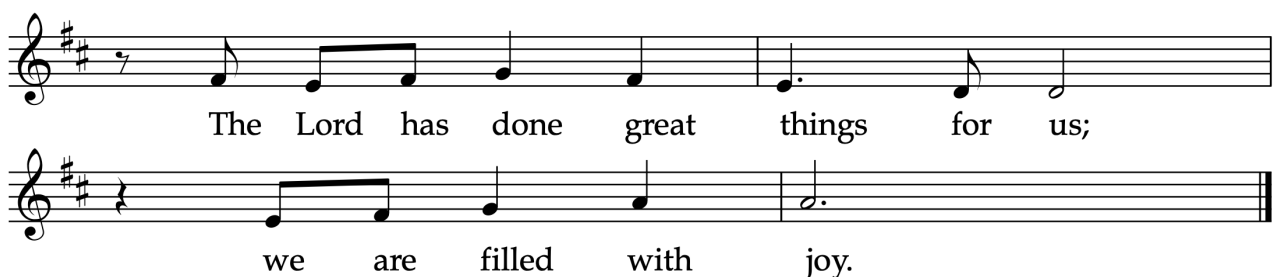
Then let us praise the Father and worship God the Son
