be bound in love together, and life eternal gain.

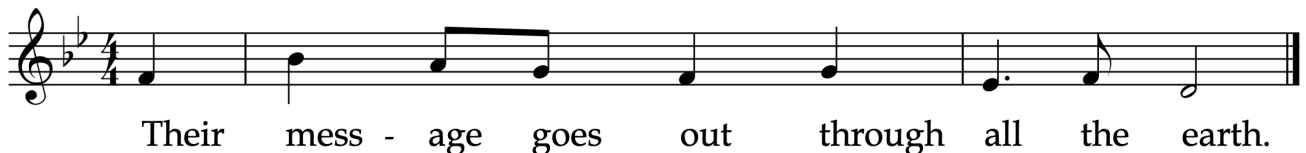
Then let us praise the Father and worship God the Son
