Saints Philip and James (F)

ENTRANCE ANTIPHON:

These are the holy men
whom the Lord chose in his own perfect love;
to them he gave eternal glory, alleluia.

FIRST READING:

1 Corinthians 15:1-8 (JB)

RESPONSORIAL PSALM:

Ps 18:2-5 (JB)

R. Their message goes out through all the earth.

or

R. Alleluia!

The heavens proclaim the glory of God
and the firmament shows forth the work of his hands.

Day unto day takes up the story
and night unto night makes known the message. **R.**

No speech, no word, no voice is heard
yet their span extends through all the earth,
their words to the utmost bounds of the world. **R.**

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION:

John 14:6,9 (JB)

Alleluia, alleluia!

I am the way, the truth, and the life, says the Lord;
Philip, whoever sees me sees the Father.
Alleluia!

GOSPEL: John 14:6-14 (JB)

COMMUNION ANTIPHON:

Lord, show us the Father, and that will be enough for us.
Whoever has seen me, Philip, has seen the Father also, alleluia.

Wednesday of the third week of Easter

ENTRANCE ANTIPHON:

Let my mouth be filled with your praise, that I may sing aloud;
my lips shall shout for joy, when I sing to you, alleluia.

FIRST READING:

Acts 8:1-8 (JB)

RESPONSORIAL PSALM:

Ps 65:1-7 (JB)

R. Let all the earth cry out to God with joy.

or

R. Alleluia.

Cry out with joy to God all the earth,
O sing to the glory of his name.
O render him glorious praise.
Say to God: 'How tremendous your deeds!' **R.**

'Before you all the earth shall bow;
shall sing to you, sing to your name.'
Come and see the works of God,
tremendous his deeds among men. **R.**

He turned the sea into dry land,
they passed through the river dry-shod.
Let our joy then be in him;
he rules for ever by his might. **R.**

ENTRANCE ANTIPHON:

Let us sing to the Lord, for he has gloriously triumphed.
The Lord is my strength and my might;
he has become my salvation, alleluia.

FIRST READING:

Acts 8:26-40 (JB)

RESPONSORIAL PSALM:

Ps 65:8-9, 16-17, 20 (JB)

R. Let all the earth cry out to God with joy.

or

R. Alleluia.

O peoples, bless our God,
let the voice of his praise resound,
of the God who gave life to our souls
and kept our feet from stumbling. **R.**

Come and hear, all who fear God.
I will tell what he did for my soul:

nor withhold his love from me. **R.**

GOSPEL: John 6:44-51 (JB)

COMMUNION ANTIPHON:

Christ died for all, that those who live
may live no longer for themselves,
but for him, who died for them and is risen,
alleluia.

GOSPEL: John 6:60-69 (JB)

COMMUNION ANTIPHON:

Father, I pray for them, that they may be one in us,
so that the world may believe it was you who sent me,
says the Lord, alleluia.
