ready.'

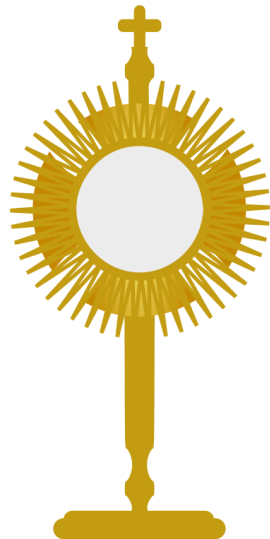
Response: *But the labourers are few.*
